Historic Walnut Mountain Shelter to be new Exhibit at Welcome Center!

A Historic Effort on the Appalachian Trail!

Carolina Mountain Club's trail crews teamed up with the U.S. Forest Service -



Cherokee National Forest and the **Appalachian Trail Conservancy** for a special project years in the making- the careful deconstruction of the historic **Walnut Mountain Shelter on the AT** south of Hot Springs.

Built in 1938 from chestnut logs by the **Civilian Conservation Corps**, this iconic shelter has stood the test of time. With 35 dedicated volunteers on site, every log and beam was carefully marked, labeled, and transported to a holding location in Hot Springs. But this is just the beginning!

In early June- Phase 2- **Reconstruction.** Bringing the shelter back to life near the **Hot Springs Welcome Center as a historical display**. This project will further cement Hot Springs' reputation as an **official AT Trail Town** and honor the legacy of the trail's rich history. The goal is to complete the shelter rebuild just in time for National Trails Day on June 7th, when we may celebrate with a community-wide work day and dedication.


